

- Mutual assistance for <u>exchange of information</u>
- Publications (Design and distribution of "MEDETEC", a <u>magazine</u> for the promotion of energy technologies in Mediterranean countries, co-financed by the European Commission, through THERMIE programme).
- Creation of a web site: www.medener.net
- Organisation of a <u>conference and exposition in</u>
 <u>Tunisia</u> about the energy technologies, renewable energies and the environment, in June 1999.

Main Results (2/2)



- Creation of a <u>database</u> with the projects being carried out in the Mediterranean area.
- Launch of an ambitious <u>awareness campaign</u> focused on young population, with the logo: "precious planet".
